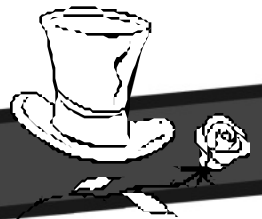

## CHOOSING A COLOR SCHEME FOR YOUR ROOM

If you feel helpless trying to pull together a color coordinated room here is a quick way to create a color scheme:

**1) Pick a Pattern** - this is the easiest way to create a color palette. Choose a pattern from any object you already have & love such as a pillow, picture or piece of furniture.

**2) See 3 Colors** - Select a light, medium and dark color from your pattern to be used as your foundation. You may want to go to a hardware store and select color chips from the paint department that match your pattern to carry with you so you know the exact match.

**3) Light, Medium and Dark** colors can affect the overall appearance

- Light- Is the *Background*- this is usually easy to achieve since most rentals are equipped with light to off-white walls.
- Medium- *Large furniture & windows* - The medium furniture will ground the room & give it a foundation as they blend with above lighter section.
- Darker- *Accessories*. Since your eye is drawn to a darker more intense color you will be able to arrange you accessories in a manner to guide the eye flowing through your room.
